

Recipe of the Month

Fresh Pear Ginger Crisp – (Can use apples too)

Ingredients

- 1 cup crushed ginger cookies (about 20 cookies)
- ½ cup old fashioned oats
- ½ cup brown sugar
- ¼ tsp of ground ginger and ¼ tsp of ground cloves
- 1/8 tsp salt
- 1/3 cup butter, softened
- 7 medium pears, peeled and thinly sliced
- 2 TBSP flour
- Vanilla ice cream optional

Directions – in a small bowl, combine and mix first 6 ingredients. Work butter into oat mixture until well combined, Refrigerate for 15 minutes.

Place pears in a small bowl and add flour and toss to coat. Transfer to a greased 8 in. square baking dish. Sprinkle with oat mixture.

Bake uncovered at 350 for 35-40 minutes or until golden and tender. Serve warm with ice cream if desired.
