Reuben Bites

Put together in minutes, they'll be gone in seconds!

1 loaf sliced party rye bread
½ c. Thousand Island salad dressing
½ lb. sliced corned beef
14 oz. can sauerkraut, drained
6 oz. pkg shredded swiss cheese

Spread dressing on top of bread slices and place on ungreased baking sheet. Slice corned beef and place on top of bread slices. Top with 1-2 tsps. of sauerkraut; sprinkle with cheese. Bake 350 degrees until cheese is melted. Serve warm.
